

## **AUSFUEL PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION – TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

### **Parties to this agreement:**

Northern Territory Cattlemen's Association Inc (ABN 87 055 308 786) and Ausfuel (ABN 24 111 881 997) (Promoters).

Any willing member of the NTCA or Entrant

### **Conditions of Entry:**

Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry. Entry into this Competition is deemed acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.

### **Eligibility:**

The competition is open to all Members and Associate Members of the NTCA.

### **Dates of Competition:**

- a) The competition commences 1st January 2010 and finishes at 5pm Friday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2010.
- b) Entries will not be acknowledged or returned. Participants have the obligation to ensure that entries are received.

### **Judgement:**

The competition will be judged by a panel of judges selected by the NTCA. Judging will take place during the conference at the Darwin Convention Centre on Friday 26 March 2010. This competition is one of skill; chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each entry will be individually judged based on originality and creative merit. The judges' decision in relation to all aspects of this competition is final and binding on all who enter and no correspondence will be entered into.

### **Number of entries:**

Competitors may enter up to three photographs under each of the following competition categories:

Section 1: Pictorial Black and White – Portrait, landscape or journalistic shot in black and white.

Section 2: Portrait - is the capture of the likeness of a person or a small group of people (a group portrait), in which the face and expression is predominant. The objective is to display the likeness, personality, and even the mood of the subject.

Section 3: NT Landscape - intended to show different spaces within the NT showing little or no human activity, using instead subjects such as strongly defined landforms, weather, and ambient light.

**Specifications:**

- a) Photographs must not be taken by professional photographers or submitted by a competitor whose principal source of income is from photography.
- b) Photographs must be submitted as high resolution jpgs of at least 300 dpi.
- c) Entry photographs are not to have been published in any other media anywhere in the world.
- d) All entries must be printed and posted to the NTCA Darwin office with a CD containing the electronic images (scans are accepted, but high resolution is preferred). Preferred size for all prints is 11"x14" (30x35cm). Minimum size for all prints 6"x4" (15x10cm). Prints must be unmounted.

**Incomplete, Illegible, Incomprehensible or Offensive Entries:**

Any entries, which at the discretion of the Promoters are deemed incomplete, illegible or incomprehensible, will be invalid and will not be included in the judging. Participants will be advised when their images are rejected from the event via email.

The Promoters reserve the right to not exhibit any entry which, in its opinion, may cause offence

**Verification and Disqualification:**

The Promoters reserve the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and participants, (including a participant's identity and membership status) and to disqualify any participant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Conditions of Entry or who tampers with the entry process. Failure by the Promoters to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

**Entry method:**

To enter, participants must:

- Take appropriate photograph(s) and scan or upload image onto a CD.
- Accept the terms and conditions of this competition.
- Completed entry forms including entrant's full name, address, email and telephone number must accompany entries. Post print/s as well as CD with electronic images to the NTCA Darwin office @ GPO Box 4845, Darwin, NT, 0801.

**Prize Winners and Prizes:**

- a) The best entry as determined by the judges in the final judging will be deemed the overall prize winner. The judges' decision will be final.
- b) There are a number of prize categories with prizes to be awarded for the following:

*Section 1: Pictorial Black and White*

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: - prize to be advised
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: - prize to be advised

*Section 2: Portrait*

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: - prize to be advised
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: - prize to be advised

*Section 3: NT Landscape*

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: - prize to be advised
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: - prize to be advised

Overall Prize Winner – Prize to be advised

- c) Prizes are non-transferable and non-redeemable for cash. Prizes or any unused portion of the prizes are not exchangeable for other goods or services and cannot be taken as cash.
- d) Prizes valued in Australian dollars. Prize values mentioned are the recommended retail value as provided by the supplier and are correct at time of printing.

**Contacting the Winners:**

- a) The section winners and overall winner will be announced at the NTCA Annual Gala Dinner on the evening of 26 March 2010.
- b) Winner(s) not in attendance will be contacted by email using the contact details provided in their entry and membership profile.
- c) Details of winners will be published on the NTCA website on or before 1 April 2010.
- d) The Promoters accept no responsibility for late, lost, incorrectly entered or misdirected entries.

**Warranty:**

By entering the competition, each participant warrants to the Promoters that the entry, (including but not limited to the photograph provided) and any other work subsequently submitted is an original, artistic work of the participant, has not been wholly or partially copied from any other design or artistic work and does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party. The participant agrees to indemnify the Promoters against all claims and costs by third parties arising from a breach of the warranty set out in this condition. Talent release forms must be available on request for any photos containing persons.

**Ownership of Entries:**

- a) Each entrant assures the Promoters that he or she is: (i) the owner of the copyright in the photograph; and (ii) that the entrant has the permission of the people shown in the entered photograph to include them in the photograph and that they have no objections of the photograph being published or used in any medium for any purpose.
- b) Each entrant assigns to the Promoters all copyright and other intellectual property rights in each photo entered into this competition. Each entrant acknowledges that the Promoters, as owners of the copyright in the photographs, may reproduce the photographs in any media or marketing for any purpose without permission or payment. The entrants agree to waive all their rights, including moral rights, in the photographs entered by the entrants in this competition.
